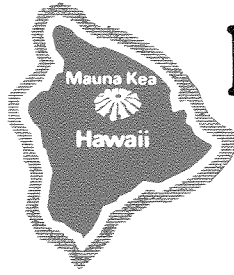

First Pictures Taken With The Prime Focus Corrector



On the night of 16/17 September, Bruce Campbell, the resident astronomer, obtained the first good plates with the UV corrector (25 arc minute field). These were of NGC 7331 and M33. The images on the plate of

M33 are of very good quality, despite problems with telescope oscillations that interrupted the exposure. A test with a double star showed that the seeing was about 0.5 arc second.
