Carol joined the CFHT staff in April as the University of Hawaii resident astronomer.

Her principal astronomical interests include: photometric and spectrophotometric studies of star clusters as probes of the evolution, structure, and chemical content in our Galaxy and other Local Group galaxies. She is also interested in data acquisition and processing techniques, specifically concerning vidicon and CCD detector systems.
